




MIRROR MONITOR QUICK START GUIDE



The ELDDIS Mirror Monitor features an integrated accident camera and a rearview/ reversing camera. All the normal user features can be accessed on the Hi-resolution 9.66" IPS touch screen display panel.

To display the menu - or show the camera images if using driving mode (see notes that follow) - tap on the screen which will then display camera images, status icons and menu buttons. These functions will be displayed for approx. 20 seconds after the screen has been tapped.



CHANGING DISPLAYED CAMERAS AND PICTURE POSITION



Swipe Left-Right to change displayed cameras

Drag position of the displayed image up or down. This function is only available when a single camera is displayed

DRIVING MODE



Power Button

In Driving Mode (see notes to follow), the display will only show the time and the date 5 seconds after the last tap on the screen.

Tapping the screen will immediately display the last selected screen

Power Button

The button is quite small and is fitted centrally underneath the monitor. This button is not intended to be used regularly as all the normal functions have been designed to be accessed through the screen.

The Monitor can be turned ON or OFF by holding the button down for 3 seconds. When power is removed the Monitor will turn off but will remember its state so when the vehicle is restarted the Monitor returns to the same state.

External connections to the Monitor



On top of the Monitor there is a slot for the TF card which the recorded footage is saved onto, and an option to connect a GPS Receiver. The USB and AV Input ports are not used on this Monitor as these connections are made through the vehicle harness.

The vehicle harness provides a connection for a reverse trigger which, when the vehicle is put into reverse, forces the monitor to display the reverse camera regardless of the Monitors status.

The Power and Camera connections are made through the vehicle harness.

SET UP MENU – RECORDING DISABLED

If Recording is Enabled the MENU options will change to the menus shown on the opposite page

Use the UP/ DOWN arrows to change menu pages, use the yellow return icon to exit menus

General Settings 1/5

- Wifi CARCAM: Off (Currently Not Supported)
- Real Line: Off (Turn ON - Overlays Reverse Grid when Reverse Gear Selected)
- Record Function: Off (Turn ON – Enables Recording)

General Settings 2/5

- V2 Display Mirror: Off (Mirror Image on Front Camera (Not usual to do this))
- V1 Display Mirror: Off (Mirror Image on Rear Camera. Note: Camera should already be mirrored as standard)
- Language: English (Select Language)

General Settings 3/5

- Beep: On (Turn audible beep alert ON/ OFF)
- Volume: 5 (Set Volume of Beep)
- Reset Setup: (Reset configuration to default)

General Settings 4/5

- Driving mode: Off (Turn Driver Mode ON/ OFF. This will turn the camera display off 5 seconds after screened tapped)
- Clock Settings: (Edit Clock Time)
- Time Zone Select: GMT (Change Time Zone)

General Settings 5/5

- Summer Time: Off (Turn on to change time to BST without adjusting clock)
- LCD Power Save: Off (Turn on to put screen in standby mode 20 seconds after last screen)
- FW Version: 20240916-WT-GC2053-AHD (Information only)

REVIEWING RECORDED VIDEOS

Recording must be turned off to enter Playback Menu

Tap the yellow return icon to exit the menu

Use the UP/ DOWN arrows to move through pages of recorded video

Select none protected videos. Tap on the vehicle icon to select required camera.

Select protected videos. Tap on the vehicle icon to select required camera.

Tap on the vehicle icon to select image

Tap on image to playback video clip

SET UP MENU – RECORDING ENABLED

Recording must be turned off – Tap Recording Icon to turn recording off

General Settings 1/6

- Wifi CARCAM: Off (Currently Not Supported)
- Movie Clip Time: 5min (Set length of each recording clip. Longer Clip Time files are bigger, but more memory usage efficient)
- Movie Mode: 1080P (Set Recording Resolution. The Higher Resolution the better quality, but uses more memory)

General Settings 2/6

- Auto Record: On (Turn Auto Record ON/ OFF. When Auto Record is turned on Video is continually recorded)
- Real Line: Off (Mirror Image on Rear Camera. Note: Camera should already be mirrored as standard)
- Record Function: On (Turn Recording ON/ OFF)

General Settings 3/6

- Sound Record: Off (Turn Audio Recording ON/ OFF)
- Parking time-lapse monitoring: Off (Turn on time lapse recording when ignition off (select fps))
- Time-lapse video recording time: 2 hours (Set time lapse records for after ignition off (select time period))

General Settings 4/6

- V2 Display Mirror: Off (Mirror Image on Front Camera (Not usual to do this))
- V1 Display Mirror: Off (Mirror Image on Rear Camera. Note: Camera should already be mirrored as standard)
- Language: English (Select Language)

General Settings 5/6

- Beep: On (Turn audible beep alert ON/ OFF)
- Volume: 5 (Set Volume of Beep)
- G-sensor recording: Low (Turn G Event Recording ON/ OFF, select Sensitivity. G Event Videos are protected and will not be overwritten)

General Settings 6/6

- Parking Monitoring: High (Turn Parking G Event Recording ON/ OFF, select Sensitivity. G Event Videos are protected and will not be overwritten)
- Reset Setup: (Reset configuration to default)
- Format SD-Card: (Format Storage Medium)

General Settings 7/6

- Driving mode: Off (Turn Driver Mode ON/ OFF. This will turn the camera display off 5 seconds after screened tapped)
- Clock Settings: (Edit Clock Time)
- Time Zone Select: GMT+01:00 (Change Time Zone)

General Settings 8/6

- Summer Time: Off (Turn on to change time to BST without adjusting clock)
- LCD Power Save: Off (Turn on to put screen in standby mode 20 seconds after last screen)
- FW Version: 20240916-WT-GC2053-AHD (Information only)
